So what is a husting? For those who don't know, a husting is a meeting where election candidates (SU Sabbatical officers candidates in this case) get a chance to present their manifesto, debate with each other, and answer questions from the audience. It's a great opportunity to see the candidates in action, understand their positions on key issues, and make an informed decision when you head to vote.
